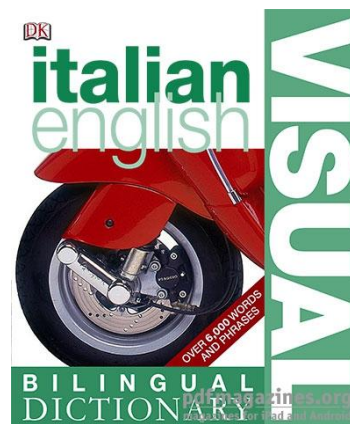
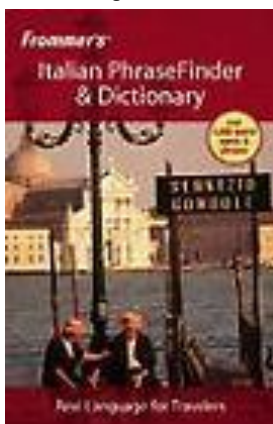
LATIN II

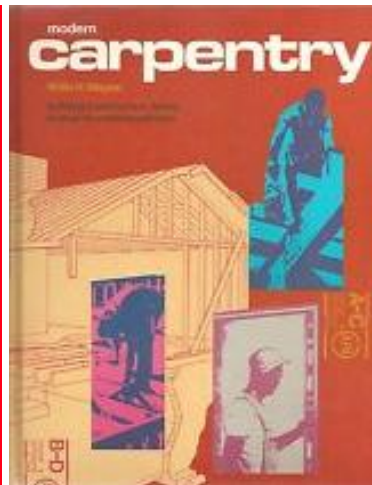
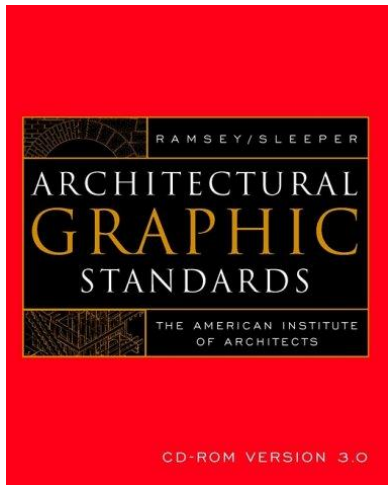
Joseph learned many Italian words and phrases and used them in conversations in Venice, Padua, and Florence (and some words in French in Southern Belgium):

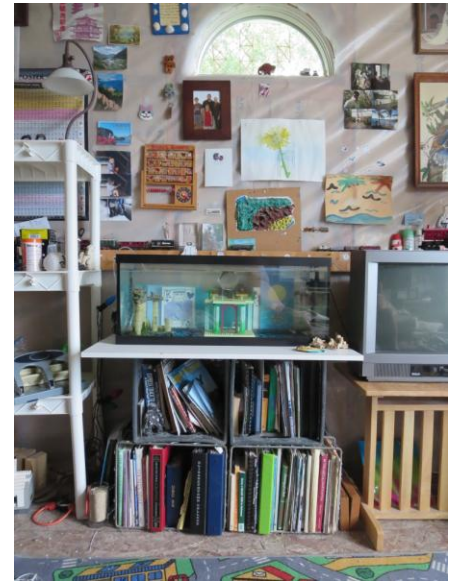
